

- Call to Order and Record Attendance – The meeting was called to order at 7:00PM by Chairman Otterbein.
Members Present: D. Otterbein, J. Key, L. Andrews, J. Grimminck and J. Kozminski.
- Approval of Minutes from October 2014 – The minutes of October 23, 2014 were reviewed by members. A motion was made by J. Key with support by J. Grimminck to approve the minutes as presented. Motion carried.



 Porta Jon – A weather event that occurred on Halloween tore the door off the outhouse in the parking lot. A resident contacted Pit Stop (who we get the port-a-Jon from) and let them know what had taken place. The company came out immediately and left a temporary restroom structure for use in the park until ours was repaired. Pit Stop brought ours back (fully repaired) and removed the temporary structure. This company has been extremely good and always goes above and beyond to provide excellent service. Additionally, the costs are very reasonable.

- Fall Cleanup Wrap Up – The fall cleanup event turnout was small, but many things were taken care of such as installation of the new signs, and many miscellaneous items.
- Park Shelter Update – At the October 2014 Sheridan Park Committee meeting, members were introduced to Deron Nelson from West Michigan Veterinary Service who was present to discuss not only the interest in the park by West Michigan Veterinary Service, but to show one of the examples of the type of shelter that Deron would like to construct for park use. Deron has a great deal of experience in traditional timber frame construction and has designed, framed and engineered many structures. Deron will be making the same park shelter presentation to the Polkton Township Board on Thursday, December 4. SPC members are encouraged to attend the board meeting for support as well as answer possible questions that may be asked by the township board.
- Maintenance Bridge Update – A meeting was held with Kevin Kieft and Matt Hulst from the engineering firm of Prein & Newhof regarding the installation of a new maintenance bridge. Both Kieft and Hulst looked at the proposed site and will be providing information to the Sheridan Park Committee regarding costs. Since Prein & Newhof engineers were on site, (and considering that Mr. Hulst engineered the suspension bridge), he and Mr. Kieft were asked if they could also look at the bridge for a possible explanation as to why a portion of the bridge (at the south end) is





Pit Stop Portable Restrooms proposed a cost-effective way to approach restroom facilities inside a power generation plant for an extended outage and executed that plan.

The JH Campbell Unit 3 outage lasted over 6 months and involved over 2,000 skilled craft working 24-hour days 7-days a week. Scheduled from October 2006 through April 2007, this spanned all major holidays and required actions to prevent freezing and units blowing over.

Craft personnel treated the units hard and Pit Stop responded well, providing facilities that were assessed by contractor management as the cleanest they had seen at a construction site.

I feel we challenged the Pit Stop organization in a very large undertaking and they were up to the challenge. I recommend them for portable restroom facilities, including response to sewage system problems.
